

# SECURITY AND PROTECTION FOR ALL

From end-users to partners, not to mention service providers and staff.

# COMPLIANCE WITH REGULATIONS

We make sure that the measures set by the authorities are put in place and applied.

# SANITARY PROTOCOL

Ensure the application of the sanitary standards in the event industry.

### COMMUNICATION

All the participants and collaborators will be informed in upstream of the measures and means deployed to ensure the safety of all.

# **BARRIER MEASURES**



#### SANITARY PASS

- · Either complete vaccination schedule and the time needed after the final injection
- Either proof of a negative test of less than 72 hours
- Either result of a positive RT-PCR test or antigen test attesting to recovery of Covid-19, dating at least 11 days and less than 6
  months



#### HAND HYGIENE

- Hydroalcoholic solution available in all strategic points
- Hand washing with soap regularly



#### **MASKS**

- Wearing a mask is compulsory for all (assembly, operation, dismantling)
- Visor masks are prohibited. As they do not protect from the particles remaining in suspension,
- Security guards and hostesses equipped with masks
- Bring your own masks



#### SOCIAL DISTANCING

- Distinction of entry and exit flows
- Materialization of queues in front of fixed reception desks, freight
- Arrange rooms to ensure appropriate space, in common areas
- Seats for the workshops and conferences rooms: every other seat, staggered between the rows

### REINFORCED CLEANING



#### **WC** areas

- Additional and more frequent cleaning
- · Cleaning monitoring documented



#### Auditorium, meeting rooms and organiser offices

• Complete daily cleaning and disinfection of rooms and furniture including doors, handles, handrails, windows, etc.



#### Stands and common areas

Complete cleaning and disinfection of aisles, common areas, self-service collective equipment (distributor, water fountains, etc.) and surfaces in contact with the hands



#### **Disinfectant wipes**

- Made available to hostesses for regular cleaning of reception desks
- Made available to partners on their stand



#### **Audiovisual material**

- After each session, cleaning and disinfection of keyboards, computer mouse, remote controls and pointers.
- Microphones equipped with disposable foam and privileged assignment of one microphone per person

# SANITAIRY MEASURES - FIRST AID - HEALTH & SAFETY



#### **Management of Suspected Cases**

- Establishment of a procedure for the isolation and removal of a suspect case (journey to avoid exposure to the public, etc.)
- Creation of an isolation area, separate from the public and separate from the Health and Safety area to receive people considered as suspected cases

# COMMUNICATION



#### Before the event

 Comexposium is in permanent contact with regulatory and health authorities in order to anticipate the evolution of COVID 19



#### On-site

Reminder of the security measures on site via:

- Floor and wall signage (e.g. barrier measures, managed flow, physical distance, meeting room display)
- Broadcast of audio messages.



#### **Health and Safety Manager**

Ensure the proper use of health and safety measures at all times,

# YOUR COMMITMENT



Do not show to the event if you have been in contact with a person carrying SARS-Cov-2 or suspected of having been infected, or if you have the following symptoms:

- Fever or feeling feverish (chills, hot-cold)
- Headache
- Unusual fatigue
- Cough and sore throat
- Sore muscles
- Difficulty breathing
- Sudden loss of smell (without nasal obstruction)
- Total disappearance of taste



You must wear a mask, at least "general public" meeting the specifications of Afnor "Spec S76-001", and maintained according to the instructions given by the manufacturer, when accessing the event



You must use the hydro-alcoholic gel when accessing the event and the various areas within it

#### Apply the barrier measures published by Santé Publique France :



- Wash your hands or use hydro-alcoholic gel as often as possible
- Cough or sneeze into your elbow or a tissue
- Use disposable tissues and throw them away immediately after use
- Greet without shaking hands and avoid hugs
